.Matters Arising:

1. Parents' evening –The prize of an I-Pod Shuffle for the Attendance competition will be displayed at the parents' evening, and this opportunity will be used to promote the PTA to the parents. Anita has agreed to ask Mr Belcher for images of the PTA to display on a laptop at the event. Katie has agreed to help set up. Anita suggested that a book is made available for new parents/ members of the PTA to leave their contact details.
2. Cycle helmet competition – This was well attended and considered to be very successful.
3. New logo competition – It has been suggested that the children might be asked to contribute to this during lunchtime break.
4. House prizes – it has been agreed not to order more prizes, but for the children to choose from the remaining stock, and to give a prize, such as a cinema trip/ Bewilderwood to the year winners.
5. Anita and Lisa have agreed to help at the end of term trick or treat stall. School uniform will also be put out at this event.

6. School disco – Katie has pointed out the confusion regarding who is allowed admittance at such events. Therefore it will be stated via a newsletter that only nursery age children require adult supervision, and those parents who wish to stay should be prepared to help.
7. Xmas Fayre – Katie has researched fund-raisers, and it has been agreed that she orders crystals for this purpose, by the 3<sup>rd</sup> December. Sherilee has offered to man the craft stall. A list of all stalls will be made available for others to offer their help. It has been agreed to give £50 as first prize for the Xmas raffle and a second prize of a meat/butcher's voucher.
8. Treasurers account: Budget; £1700. £430 will be used to pay for the Xmas pantomime.
